

Saito College Achievers Scholarship

1. The Saito College Achievers Scholarship was created to award partial scholarships to students with outstanding results in their exams and a passion to continue their education in design.
2. Minimum results accepted for this scholarship are as below

SPM / UEC	Minimum of 3As (combination of A+, A, A-)
STPM	Minimum GPA of 3.00 in 3 subjects

3. The scholarship application will need to be vetted by the Saito College Academic Board.
4. The student can choose to continue his/her studies in the following selected fields
 - a. Diploma in Multimedia Design
 - b. Diploma in Graphic Design
 - c. Diploma in Interior Design
 - d. Diploma in Creative Advertising
 - e. Diploma in Security Management
5. The Scholarship is only applicable for Malaysian Students age between 17–20.
6. The Scholarship is only valid for the January 2012 Intake.
7. Trial exam results of the student can be accepted for entry for this scholarship. The actual results will need to be produced by the student to verify the results.
8. The Scholarship recipient is not entitled for any other promotion schemes and incentives if they take this scholarship.
9. The scholar will be given a partial scholarship of **30% off** the total academic fees. This does not include the registration fees, MQA subjects and other administration fees.
10. The fees are based on the 2012 fees.
11. The recipient is required to maintain high level of academic and co-curricular achievement. The recipient should be a student ambassador and promote the good name of the College. In addition, the recipient is required to set exemplary behaviour and to contribute actively in student activities and College functions.
12. In the event that a student decides to discontinue his / her studies, the scholarship will be forfeited and the recipient is required to reimburse the College the awarded amount during his / her period of studies in Saito College.
13. Applicant can only enjoy one scholarship/ bursary / fee waiver at any one time.
14. The scholarship awarded will be revoked should recipients breach the College's rules and regulations.
15. The scholarship is given in the form of tuition fee waivers and is credited to the accounts of the students. They are non-transferable, non-convertible to cash, and non-redeemable for cash.
16. If the student fails to achieve the entry requirement results required for the admission into the diploma programme, the College reserves the right to revoke the scholarship offer and charge the original tuition fees to the student and/or drop the student from the course.
17. This Scholarship Offer ends on **20th December 2011**.
