

# Tetsuo Saito Founder's Scholarship

1. The Tetsuo Saito Founder's Scholarship was created in memory of Saito College founder, Mr. Tetsuo Saito.
2. The Scholarship will award full scholarships to outstanding students with exceptional aptitude in academia and creativity.
3. Minimum results accepted for this scholarship are as below

SPM / UEC	Minimum of 7As (combination of A+, A, A-) 4 Portfolios of Art/Design Work.
STPM	Minimum GPA of 3.00 in 3 subjects 4 Portfolios of Art/Design Work

4. Our aim is to expose the student to the top minds and companies in the Malaysian Creative Industry.
5. The scholarship application will need to be vetted by the Saito College Academic Board.
6. The student can choose to continue his studies in the following selected fields
  - a. Diploma in Multimedia Design
  - b. Diploma in Graphic Design
  - c. Diploma in Interior Design
  - d. Diploma in Creative Advertising
7. The Scholarship is only applicable for Malaysian Students age between 17–20.
8. The Scholarship is only valid for the January 2012 Intake.
9. Trial exam results of the student can be accepted for entry for this scholarship. The actual results will need to be produced by the student to verify the results.
10. As part of the term of this scholarship, the student will undergo an internship program with the Scholarship Partner upon the 7<sup>th</sup> Semester of the Scholar's studies. The duration of the internship program will be pre-determined by the College to meet the requirement of the academic program.
11. After the Scholar has completed their studies, the Industry Partner may offer the Scholar suitable employment in the company.
12. The Scholarship recipient is not entitled for any other promotion schemes and incentives if they take this scholarship.
13. The recipient is required to maintain high level of academic and co-curricular achievement. The recipient should be a student ambassador and promote the good name of the College. In addition, the recipient is required to set exemplary behaviour and to contribute actively in student activities and College functions.
14. In the event that a student decides to discontinue his / her studies, the scholarship will be forfeited and the recipient is required to reimburse the College the awarded amount during his / her period of studies in Saito College.
15. Applicant can only enjoy one scholarship/ bursary / fee waiver at any one time.
16. The scholarship awarded will be revoked should recipients breach the College's rules and regulations.
17. The scholarship is given in the form of tuition fee waivers and is credited to the accounts of the students. They are non-transferable, non-convertible to cash, and non-redeemable for cash.
18. If the student fails to achieve the entry requirement results required for the admission into the diploma programme, the College reserves the right to revoke the scholarship offer and charge the original tuition fees to the student and/or drop the student from the course.
